








CAREER DEVELOPMENT **PROGRAMME (CDP)**

LANGUAGE TRAINING PLUS WORK EXPERIENCE PLACEMENT LEADING TO EDEXCEL QUALIFICATION



Our unique CDP programme is our most popular course for intermediate level students.

Designed to equip students with the skills and language ability to undertake successful work experience in a British company, this programme offers students a unique pathway of progression, where learners have the opportunity to acquire career development skills and a nationally recognised British qualification, in conjunction with a period of work experience in the UK.

Students have the possibility to choose to study in one of our centres in London or Eastbourne. This course enables learners to analyse their own potential via the practical work experience element as they work towards a nationally recognised qualification.

THE COURSE

CLASSROOM BASED COMPONENT

The classroom based course components cover all the skills needed to undertake a successful placement, from the initial process of applying for work experience and attending an interview, to recognising and developing self confidence and key skills to enhance employment opportunities upon return to their home country.

Modules studied depending on length of course include:

- Project management skills
- Personal skills for leadership

INTERNSHIP PROGRAMMES

Twin's Internship programmes are designed to meet the needs of students of all ages and backgrounds. We match the career objectives of each participant on the programme to one of our 5000 companies in all sectors and professions.

LEVEL 1: 16-18 YEARS From 2 weeks plus

This programme has been designed for adventurous young people who wish to travel abroad for their first international work experience. It is specifically aimed at the younger trainee, with an intermediate level of English (minimum age 16 maximum 18). It is targeted at students in full time education, in their gap year between school and university or those who simply wish to gain work experience in an international setting.

English is improved in the work place and life skills are enhanced simultaneously.



LEVEL 2: 18 YEARS + From 3 weeks plus

This programme offers a unique way in which to develop personal and career goals through work experience in most vocational areas of study. The programme aims to provide a means of improving existing English language skills in a professional environment, enhance employment opportunities within an increasingly competitive employment market and increase awareness of international business and practical work experience.

We guarantee work placements that will match the career objectives of each trainee. Placements range from 3 weeks plus, the longer the placement the more beneficial the work experience.

LEVEL 3: 21 YEARS From 16 weeks plus

This programme is the highest level of placement we provide, it is aimed at graduates with an advanced level of English and some previous work experience enabling them to participate in a placement programme in London and receive an allowance of £250 per month towards travel and lunches. Graduates attending this programme are therefore able to bridge the gap between the theoretical knowledge that they have gained at university and the reality of working in a British business environment. Our placements enable students to develop professional skills, as well as improving the fluency of their general and business English.

Companies are selected on the basis that they provide our trainees with a good position, clear job description and projects focused on their fields of study.

Our experienced placement team takes full responsibility for each candidate, from the point of predeparture, by finding a suitable placement that is appropriate to the client's career expectations. Once in the UK, students attend a full induction and are guided through their first day on placement. Students are assigned a placement officer to help them settle into life in the UK and support them through their period of time with us.

Students are monitored throughout their placement and on successful completion are awarded a Twin placement certificate as well as a reference from their UK employer.

NB. Part-time internships can be offered as a combination of morning lessons and afternoon internship in general administration roles. To qualify for this programme students must enrol for a minimum of 4 weeks.



PAID WORK EXPERIENCE

This programme has been specifically designed to provide practical work experience for those interested in the hospitality sector. The programme offers students the minimum wage plus subsidised board and lodging whilst on placement.

The programme aims to improve international understanding and give students the opportunity to explore tourist areas all over the UK. The hospitality companies are of all sizes and can be located anywhere in the UK from the Isle of Sky to Cornwall and range from family based businesses to 5 star hotels.

INTENSIVE EMPLOYMENT PREPARATORY COURSE:

All students must attend a Preparatory English Language course for a minimum of 1 week prior to their placement which will include workshops dedicated to providing students with all the necessary skills to get the most out of their experience.

Content of the course:

3 Hours standard course in the morning + 1h workshop in the afternoon:

- → Interview skills and techniques
- → Customer service skills
- → Health & safety/food hygiene
- Hospitality industry-specific vocabulary
- Placement confirmation
- → Travel confirmation
- Welcome pack and student handbook



NB: Please note all participants will be tested upon arrival and before going to their placement to ensure they have the level of English required for the programme. If they do not have the required level, they will need to do additional weeks of General English.

LEVEL 1:

This programme is suitable for students wishing to gain international work experience and who have an intermediate level of English. Placements include general assistants, bar staff, restaurant staff, housekeeping and other key roles in the hospitality industry. Previous experience in the field is not essential but would be an advantage.



LEVEL 2:

This programme is aimed at hospitality students with a higher intermediate or advanced level of English and relevant previous work experience in the field.

Students are guaranteed to be placed in front office type positions or trainee hotel management positions. Students can also choose their placements and placement location. We welcome applicants from students studying hotel management and are able to match students with larger hotel chains.

EXPERIENCED CHEF PROGRAMME:

This is aimed at trainees with experience working in kitchens, trainee chef or those who have chef qualifications, are trainees with an interest in catering, or those trying to gain catering experience. The company provides accommodation, food and a training allowance equivalent to the UK national minimum wage. Deductions from the allowance will be made for tax and national insurance and there may be charges for any other services provided by the host company such as accommodation and food. Fully trained chefs will earn more than the minimum wage.




OUR LONDON CENTRE





Most students take half-board (breakfast and an evening meal) with their homestay provider, but it is also possible to request full board or bed and breakfast.
