This example is based on a one week course for 12 – 15 students:

- Single room homestay for one leader

Language in London was established in 1989 and is accredited by the British Council and a member of English UK and Tandem International.

The school is the first winner in the world of the British Council Prize for Innovation in English Teaching. The school is in the centre of London and occupies an elegant five-storey Georgian building (1776), which backs onto the British Museum.

Cultural Experience Programme

Cultural Experience is an English course – but an English course with a difference. We understand that school groups travelling to London want something different to the type of learning they can have at home.

This course takes an active “heads up” approach and is unique to this school. All the lessons are designed to motivate and enthuse the students while giving the chance to get to know London and fall in love with the language.

The content changes over the year as exhibitions open and close but the basic concept remains the same. Lessons are designed using exhibits and the language that describes them (written texts and audio). One day may involve the language of comparisons in the National Portrait Gallery and another might be a project on the history of money in the British Museum. Student presentations are a key feature of this programme, which has twin aims of developing speaking and building vocabulary.
