A job in the UK

If you have a Working Holiday Visa or a EU/EEA passport, you can get a job while you are in London. Students on a Student Visa, Extended Student Visitor Visa, or General Student Visa cannot work.

There are many jobs in London for students in shops, cafes, restaurants, hotels and other areas. The minimum wage in the UK is £6.08 per hour if you are over 21.

Arriving in the UK & Visas

We can give students general advice about applying for a visa. For more detailed information speak to your travel agency, contact the British Embassy in your country or read information on <http://www.ukvisas.gov.uk>

- If you are an EU citizen you do not need a visa to study in the UK.
- Non EU students may apply for three different kinds of visas. A Student Visitor Visa, an Extended Student Visitor Visa, and a General Student Visa (Tier 4).

Help with your Student Visa

A General Student Visa allows students to extend their visa while in the UK. You must study for a minimum of 16 weeks in order to apply. You must also provide evidence of your current English level (which must be CEFR level B1 or above) and may be required to do an oral interview.

To get a General Student Visa, students must apply for a Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS). Malvern House is on the Register of Sponsors and is able to issue these documents. You will receive thirty points for this document. And ten points from documents showing the funds necessary to study in the UK. The Republic of Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man are Common Travel Areas and do not have passport control. Students cannot get entry clearance or have their Visa stamped and would be prohibited from starting their course.

Help with your Student Visitor Visa and Extended Student Visitor Visa

A Student Visitor Visa can be used for courses of less than 24 weeks, for students who have a lower level of English. This visa is appropriate for short courses. Non EU students cannot study on a Visitor/Tourist Visa. You must get a Student Visitor Visa on entry. You cannot extend or work with this visa. Visa Nationals (eg: Colombia, Russia, Thailand and Turkey), studying for less than six months, you will need to apply for entry clearance before you travel to the UK. Non-Visa National (this includes Brazil, Japan, Korea and Mexico) studying for less than six months, you can choose to apply for entry clearance before you travel or make your visa application at the airport on arrival in the UK.

Extended Student Visitor Visa

Since 10 January 2011 students have the possibility to apply for an Extended Student Visitor Visa. An Extended Student Visitor Visa can only be used for English Language courses and the courses must be longer than 24 weeks. You will need to apply for entry clearance before you travel to the UK regardless if you are a Non-Visa or Visa national. Like the Student Visitor Visa, the Extended Student Visitor does not allow students to work or extend the visa in the UK.

Getting to Central London

Once you know your travel details, it's time to decide how you will travel to your new home. Most of our students arrive at one of London's airports, book an airport transfer or travel by train, tube or bus. If you arrive in the UK after 8pm and are staying in Host Family Accommodation, you must book a transfer. If you prefer to get to your accommodation on your own, go to the Transport for London Journey Planner to have precise directions of how to travel from any airport to any given location: www.tfl.gov.uk

There are four major airports serving London. These are all quite far from London city centre. Follow our instructions to get to central London or ask for help from airport help desks.

Airport transfers, shuttles & taxis

Students arriving in the UK after 8pm must book a transfer if they stay in Malvern House accommodation. This is a personalised service that will take you and your luggage, from the airport to your accommodation.

Our drivers will carry a red Malvern House sign with your name on it. Do not go with a driver from another company or without your name, as some unlicensed companies charge large amounts of money to newly arrived foreigners at airports.

Our drivers will wait for 2 hours after the arrival of your flight. If you cannot see the driver holding a red sheet with your name, go to the Information Desk in the airport and wait for your name to be announced.

TAXIS:

If you have not booked transport with Malvern House please make sure that you go in a licensed taxi or mini-cab.

In an Emergency

Please call Malvern House 24hr emergency line on **+44 (0) 7980 648 743**; only in case of an emergency. The British Emergency number for Police, Ambulance and Fire Brigade is 999.

For Your Safety

- Please carry your money, passport and travel documents close to your body, preferably in a pocket or pouch under your clothing.
- Make sure your luggage is securely locked and within eyesight at all times.
- The UK is generally quite safe in populated well-lit areas but students should exercise the same caution one would practise in all major cities.

Students must book a return transfer to and from the airport and parents must sign release forms. Students must also stay in half board hostfamilies if they take accommodation with Malvern House as required by British Council regulation.

Your Holidays in the UK

In addition to your programme of study you are entitled to holidays, depending on the number of weeks you book. Please see the fee sheet. ie: Thirty six weeks of study entitles you to eight weeks of holiday. You can book your holiday dates when you arrive in London at Reception or on E-reception. You must use 1 week of your holidays at Christmas time.

School Closure Dates 2012 - 13

Attendance in Class

Students must attend class every day except for scheduled holidays, school closure dates or when ill. A doctor's certificate is required. Poor attendance will be reported to the Home Office according to Tier 4 guidelines.

Accommodation

Accommodation must be booked from Sunday to Sunday. Please read our Accommodation Guidelines (available on our website) before booking accommodation. Accommodation is only confirmed after visa confirmation. We require 2 weeks to arrange accommodation after receiving notice. Students under 18 must stay in hostfamily accommodation with half board and have a return airport transfer.

Cancelling a Course

Changes to course value will not be made after Enrolment Confirmation, or CAS (confirmation of acceptance of studies) have been issued. Students may upgrade their programme in time or value, but not reduce it.

Class Level

All new students must take the Malvern House placement test. Our level test is available on our website or at www.go4test.com. You should do this test immediately after you have received your course confirmation, with your student number. This saves you time on your first day and helps us to plan your class schedule. If you are unable to take the test online, you may do so at any reception on your first day. For specialist classes with level requirements (e.g. business, exam, Fast track and Malvern House Foundation and Pre- Masters courses) there is a minimum language requirement. If you do not reach this in the placement test, you must begin your programme in General English.
