

#### HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION


Staying with a host family is by far the most popular way of experiencing life in Britain. Over 20,000 students stay in one of our homestay centres in London and throughout the UK each year. We have around 60 host family centres throughout the UK and 16 centres in London alone. We work with a well-established and trusted network of high quality host families across the UK. Our experienced in-house accommodation department organises accommodation in South East London, Eastbourne and Salisbury. Outside of these areas we work with carefully selected local area representatives who organise accommodation in all other areas. Our local area representatives are the first point of contact for groups, meeting them on arrival and departure, as well as twice a day throughout their stay to ensure that the highest level of satisfaction is achieved.

Homestay accommodation is usually on a full board basis: bed, breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal. Host families are also provided for group leaders and coach drivers, but we can also book local guest houses and hotels if preferred. Guests are accommodated in groups of two, three or four per family. We can provide English lessons at many of our homestay centres and through our own British Council schools in London, Eastbourne and Salisbury.










