Some help for you...

1. What is General English?

This is the standard course that everybody should take and is the best way for you to move from the English level you are now to the next one. Each week a 15 hour General English course includes a balance of speaking, listening, reading, writing practice and help for you to learn more grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation. The levels for General English are from elementary to high advanced. We have never met a student who doesn't need to study some General English!

2. What is Double General English, General English Saver and General English Super Intensive?

Double is 2 General English courses at the same time, which means you study for 30 hours per week. Saver is classes in the afternoons and is for courses of 24 weeks or more. Super Intensive combines General English (15 hours) with Conversation (5 hours) and 1-to-1 lessons (5 hours) and is perfect for 1 to 4 weeks.

3. What happens in the Conversation class?

This is an extra 5 hours a week (combined with General English), where you can practise every part of speaking and listening. In some lessons you will discuss the news in others you will prepare a presentation or take part in a role play. In 2008 and 2009 the General English + Conversation course was the most popular with our students.

4. Are 1-to-1 lessons a good idea?

We think 1-to-1 lessons are good if you have something you really want to practise which will not be included in a group lesson. Our students choose these lessons to prepare for a job interview or an exam, to learn language important for their work or because they only have a short time to study and want an intensive course. We recommend "C5" (General English + 1-to-1) or "C6" (General English + Conversation + 1-to-1).

5. What is IELTS?

This is an exam which you take if you are going to university. It is a test in academic English and the exam can be booked for any weekend.

6. What are Cambridge exams?

These are tests in General English to see what your level is. The exams are very popular and recognised all over the world. We will help you prepare for First Certificate, Advanced or Proficiency. The exams are in March (only FCE and CAE), June, August (only FCE) and December.

7. What is the Books and Films course?

You can practise English and discover more about British culture by discussing books and films. You will find this a very relaxing and motivating way to learn English.

8. What is the Business English course?

We aim to help you to do in English what you can do in your language. Through role play, discussions, presentations and negotiations you will practise the language skills you need to be confident to use English in your work.

9. What is Cultural Experience?

Cultural Experience is a special course designed by Language in London. The course won the British Council prize for innovation in English teaching and is unique because the English lessons take place outside the school in London's museums and galleries. Our students love this course and we recommend that everyone tries one week of it!

10. What is Cultural Experience 40+?

This is a Cultural Experience course for older students. Every year we run this special programme because it's a great way to practise English, see London and make friends with people who are like you. The programme includes lessons and extra social activities.

11. What is the Cultural Holiday?

This is a combination package and the best way to have a holiday in London and learn English. On one week you take Cultural Experience and on the next you do General English and Books and Films.

12. What is the Great London Experience?

This is a special combination package if you are studying 6 months or more. During your General English course you will also do Cultural Experience, IELTS, Cambridge exams and English for Work.

13. What are the part-time evening courses?

These are one, two or three evenings per week and are designed for people who are living and working in London and still want to learn more English or prepare for an exam. The courses are all for 12 weeks.

14. What is work experience placement?

This is a chance for you to experience working in a company in London. We arrange unpaid professional placements, which are usually between 4 and 12 weeks. These will be based on your academic qualifications and experience as well as your English level.

15. What is the summer zig zag timetable?

All courses in summer (July and August) are on a zig zag timetable. This means that you will have some lessons in the morning and some lessons in the afternoon. We arrange social activities for the times you are not in class. The school has used this timetable for five years and it is very popular with our students.

16. Do I need to buy a book?

You will need to buy a book for most courses and the average cost is £20.

17. Will you book my exam for me?

We will make all the arrangements for your Cambridge or IELTS exams. The cost is between £100 – 125.

18. What happens if I think I am in the wrong level or not happy with my course?

There is someone at the school – the Director of Studies – whose job is to make sure you are happy and learning. If there is any problem then you just make an appointment for a chat and we will help you.

19. What do I do now?
